RE: MRI Safe Declaration

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is advising patients and healthcare providers that patients may be injured if they wear masks with metal parts and coatings during magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scans.

Some masks on the market contain metal components, such as metal nose clips used to adjust the sealing of the mask's nose bridge, or may contain metal (such as silver or copper) antibacterial coatings for antibacterial purposes, which may cause burns to patients during MRI examinations. The FDA recommends that patients wear a metal-free mask during the MRI procedure.

Zimi specializes in producing frame masks, using plastic frames as support. These masks have a plastic nose bridge with a sealing ring to ensure a tight fit around the nose. Zimi's masks do not contain any metal or antibacterial coatings. Therefore, Zimi masks can be safely used during MRI (magnetic resonance imaging).
